




- Began our overdose fatality review (OFR) in 2020

- Hired an OFR Coordinator in September 2022

RECOMMENDATIONS AND TEAM ENGAGEMENT



Short-term Actions

- Emergency department nurses educate patients on medications prescribed
- Law enforcement distribute peer recovery information and connect individuals with service providers and resources

Intermediate Actions

- Implement Handle With Care
- Provide grief support

Long-term Actions

- Renovate recovery residence/safe housing
- Plan integrated reentry and correctional support (IRACS) program


