#### **Rhode Island: The Ocean State**



- Size: 37 miles wide x 48 miles long
- 400 miles of coastline
- 39 municipalities: 8 cities and 31 towns
- Five counties
- Population: ~1.1 million people



#### **Overdose Fatality Review in Rhode Island**

- Statewide team only
- Year OFR started: 2016
- Legislation enacted: 2018
- Number of active members: 30
- Funding source: Opioid settlements
- Number of fatal overdose deaths in 2023: 404



# **OFR Mini-Grant: The Opioid Safe Community Project**



- West Greenwich, RI
- Rural community
- Implementation by the town's emergency medical services (EMS) agency
- 13 NaloxBoxes installed along with training



#### **The Opioid Safe Community Project**

**Recommendation:** Increase access to and saturation of naloxone by promoting the utilization of auto renewal naloxone prescriptions, over-the-counter naloxone (as it becomes available), NaloxBoxes, and harm reduction vending machines in overdose hotspots.




